Kilowatt Smackdown is a community-wide student energy assessment competition where students compete to see who can perform the most free energy assessments for local businesses in Takoma Park.

Through GIC's mobile platform, the Green Energy Management System (GEMS), students will conduct short, free energy surveys that will prescribe energy efficiency recommendations for businesses to easily and cost-effectively lower their energy usage and environmental impact. GIC will provide students with all of the training and tools needed - including training on GEMS and sample language for communicating to local businesses - so there is no prior experience necessary. Students will gain professional skills, internship opportunities, and prizes.
