Outreach and Restoration Grants

Grants for larger stormwater projects; ranges between \$50,000 to \$125,000. Open to nonprofits, faith-based groups, community associations, schools, and other groups.

Rockville Project Priorities
Permeable pavers or pavement, rain gardens, cisterns, and more on faith-based organization properties.
Tree planting projects on public or private property.
Sustainable native landscaping such as low maintenance meadows, conservation landscapes, wildlife habitat.
Projects that assist or benefit underserved communities.
Educating or engaging the community in reducing stormwater pollution and sustainable landscaping.
Nature-based solutions to mitigate the effects of climate change and build resiliency.

RainScapes Rebates

Rebates for small stormwater projects; maximum of \$5,000 per property. Open to residential and non-profit properties.

Project	Rebate
Conservation landscaping	\$5 or \$6/ sq. ft.
Rain gardens	\$10/ sq. ft.
Rain barrels	\$1/ gallon
Cisterns	\$1/ gallon
Tree canopy	\$150/ tree
Pavement removal	\$3 or \$6/ sq. ft.
Permeable paver retrofit	\$14/ sq. ft.
Green roof	\$9/ sq. ft
